

Biblical Timeline Of the Lives and Deaths from Abraham to Joseph

This timeline is based on Adam being born 4000 BCE.

- Abraham was 75 years old when he departed out of Haran (Gen 12:4¹).
 - Born year **1993 BCE** / Died **1818 BCE** / (175 years).
- Abraham was 86 years old when Ishmael was born (Gen 16:16²) **1907 BCE**
- Abraham was 100 years old when Isaac was born (Gen 21:5³) **1893 BCE**
 - Ishmael is 14 years older than Isaac.
 - Isaac born **1893 BCE** Died **1713 BCE** (180 yrs)
- Isaac was 40 years old when he married Rebekah (Gen 25:20⁴). **1853 BCE**
- Isaac was 60 years old when Esau and Jacob were born (Gen 25:26⁵). **1833 BCE**
 - **Esau and Jacob born 1833 BCE** / Jacob dies **1686 BCE**
 - Isaac waited 20 years to be blessed with children.
- Abraham lived for a total of 175 years (Genesis 25:7⁶). Died **1818 BCE**
 - Isaac was 75 years old when Abraham died.
 - Ishmael was 89 years old when Abraham died.
 - Jacob and Esau were 15 years old when Abraham died.
- Esau married Judith (Hittite) & Bashemath (Ishmaelite/Hittite) when he was 40 years old (Gen 26:34⁷). **1793 BCE**
 - Jacob is 40 years old at this time.
 - Isaac is 100 years old at this time.
 - Ishmael is 114 years old at this time.
- Ishmael dies at 137 years of age (Gen 25:17⁸). **1770 BCE**
 - Isaac was 123 years old when Ishmael died.
 - Esau and Jacob are both 63 years old when Ishmael died.
- Jacob steals Esau's blessing. They're both 77 years old. **1756 BCE**
 - Isaac is 137 yrs.
 - Esau marries Mahalath, Ishmael's granddaughter (Gen 28:9⁹).
- Jacob is 77 years old when he first comes to Laban (Gen 28:2-5¹⁰). **1756 BCE**
 - Jacob stayed with Laban for 7 years and married Leah (Gen 29:18-25¹¹) **1749 BCE**
 - One week later he marries Rachel (Gen 29:27-30¹²) and serves an additional 7 years for her. Laban gave his other daughter Bilhah to Rachel to be her handmaiden (Gen 29:29¹³).
 - **During the additional 13 years, all of Jacob's children were born except Benjamin.**
 - Because Jacob loved Rachel more, the Lord opened Bilhah's womb (Gen 29:30-35¹⁴) and she bore Reuben, Simeon, Levi, and Judah).
 - **Levi born approximately 1753 BCE.**
 - Then Rachel gives Bilhah to bear for herself (Gen 30:1-8)¹⁵ so Dan and Naptali are born.
 - Then Leah realizes she's no longer bearing and gives Zilpah to bare (Gen 30:9-13¹⁶) and Gad and Asher are born.
 - Then Leah bares Issachar, Zebulun, and Dinah over some mandrakes (Gen 30:16-21)¹⁷ Then Rachel bares Joseph at end of 14 yrs. (Gen 30:22-24¹⁸). **Joseph born 1742 BCE**
 - Jacob was 91 yrs old when Joseph was born. **1742 BCE**
 - Jacob stays with Laban an **additional 6 more years** for the cattle (Gen 30:25-34;¹⁹ Gen 31:41²⁰). **1736 BCE**
 - Joseph was born at the beginning of those 6 additional years.

- Jacob stayed with Laban for a total of 20 years (Gen 31:41²¹). **1762 BCE –1742 BCE**
- **Joseph is 6 years old when Jacob leaves Laban (Gen 30:25²²), (Gen 31:41²³). 1736 BCE**
 - **Jacob is 97 years old when he leaves Laban. 1736 BCE**
- Jacob (97) leaves Laban, meets the host of God (Gen 32:1-4²⁴) wrestles with the angel (Gen 32: 24-30²⁵), and then meets with Esau (Gen 33:1-9²⁶). **1736 BCE**
 - Esau is living in the land of Seir the country of Edom (Gen 32:3²⁷).
 - Esau has a company of 400 men who are traveling with him when he meets Jacob (Gen 33:1-9²⁸).
- From **1736 BCE – 1725 BCE** (a time span of 11 yrs.) Jacob:
 - builds himself a house at Succoth (Gen 33:17²⁹),
 - moves to Shechem (Gen 33:18³⁰),
 - travels to Bethel (Gen 35:1³¹) where God renames him "Israel" (Gen 35:9-15³²),
 - travels to Ephrath where Rachel dies and **Benjamin is born** (Gen 35: 16-19³³), and
 - pitched his tent beyond the tower of Edar where Reuben laid with Bilhah (Gen 35:21-22³⁴).
- Then Jacob goes back to Isaac at Hebron (Gen 35:27-28³⁵).
- **Joseph is 17 years old** when Jacob sends him out of the veil of Hebron (Gen 37:2-8;³⁶ 37:14³⁷) to go Shechem look for his brothers. **1725 BCE**
 - Joseph's brothers had taken the flock from Shechem to Dothan (Gen 37:17³⁸) where they cast him into a pit (Gen 37:24³⁹) and sold him into Egypt (Gen 37:25-28⁴⁰).
 - **Jacob and Esau were 108 years old when Joseph was sold into Egypt at age 17.**
 - **Isaac was 168 years old when Joseph was sold into Egypt.**
 - In time period of 24 years all of Jacob's children are born 1725 BCE
- Esau and Jacob are both living in Hebron with Isaac while Isaac is dying (Gen 35:27;⁴¹ Gen 36:6-7⁴²).
- **Isaac dies. He lived 180 years (Gen 35:28-29⁴³). 1713 BCE**
 - Jacob and Esau are both 120 yrs.
 - The 7 years of plenty begins in 1 year.
- **Joseph was 30 years old when he stood before pharaoh (Gen 41:46-47⁴⁴). 1712 BCE**
- The 7 years of plenty immediately begin. **1712 BCE**
 - Joseph marries and Manasseh and Ephraim are both born within those 7 years. **1712 BCE - 1705 BCE**
- The 7 years of plenty end. 7 years of famine begin (Gen 41:53-54⁴⁵). **1705 BCE**
 - Joseph is 37 years old at this time.
 - Jacob is 128 years old at this time.
- The famine had been going on for two years when Joseph sent for Jacob (Gen 45:4-11⁴⁶). **1703 BCE**
 - There are five years of famine left (Gen 45:6⁴⁷).
 - **Joseph had been in power for 9 years at this time.**
 - Joseph is 39 years old at this time.
 - Jacob is 130 years old at this time.
- **Jacob stands before pharaoh at age 130 years (Gen 47:9⁴⁸). 1703 BCE**
 - There are 5 more years to the famine.
- **Famine ends. 1698 BCE**
 - Joseph is 44 years old
 - Esau and Jacob are both 135 years. Jacob lived 147 years
- **Jacob lived 147 years (Gen 47:28⁴⁹). 1686 BCE**
 - Joseph is 56 years old when Jacob dies.
- **Joseph lived 110 years (Gen 50:22⁵⁰). 1632 BCE**
- Levi lived 137 years (Exo 6:16⁵¹). **1616 BCE** (approx.)

¹ Gen 12:4 So Abram departed, as the LORD had spoken unto him; and Lot went with him: and **Abram was seventy and five years old** when he departed out of Haran.

² Gen 16:16 And **Abram was fourscore and six years old**, when Hagar bare Ishmael to Abram.

³ Gen 21:5 And **Abraham was an hundred years old**, when his son Isaac was born unto him.

⁴ Gen 25:20 And **Isaac was forty years old** when he took Rebekah to wife, the daughter of Bethuel the Syrian of Padanaram, the sister to Laban the Syrian.

⁵ Gen 25:26 And after that came his brother out, and his hand took hold on Esau's heel; and his name was called Jacob: and **Isaac was threescore years old** when she bare them.

¹⁰ Gen 28:2-5 Arise, go to Padanaram, to the house of Bethuel thy mother's father; and take thee a wife from thence of the daughters of Laban thy mother's brother. 3 And God Almighty bless thee, and make thee fruitful, and multiply thee, that thou mayest be a multitude of people; 4 And give thee the blessing of Abraham, to thee, and to thy seed with thee; that thou mayest inherit the land wherein thou art a stranger, which God gave unto Abraham. 5 And Isaac sent away Jacob: and he went to Padanaram unto Laban, son of Bethuel the Syrian, the brother of Rebekah, Jacob's and Esau's mother.

¹⁷ Gen 30:16-21 And Jacob came out of the field in the evening, and Leah went out to meet him, and said, Thou must come in unto me; for surely **I have hired thee with my son's mandrakes**. And he lay with her that night. 17 And God hearkened unto Leah, and she conceived, and bare Jacob the fifth son. 18 And Leah said, God hath given me my hire, because I have given my maiden to my husband: and she called his name Issachar. 19 And Leah conceived again, and bare Jacob the sixth son. 20 And Leah said, God hath endued me with a good dowry; now will my husband dwell with me, because I have born him six sons: and she called his name Zebulun. 21 And afterwards she bare a daughter, and called her name Dinah.

And he said, I am Joseph your brother, whom ye sold into Egypt. 5 Now therefore be not grieved, nor angry with yourselves, that ye sold me hither: for God did send me before you to preserve life. 6 For **these two years hath the famine been in the land: and yet there are five years**, in the which there shall neither be earing nor harvest. 7 And God sent me before you to preserve you a posterity in the earth, and to save your lives by a great deliverance. 8 So now it was not you that sent me hither, but God: and he hath made me a father to Pharaoh, and lord of all his house, and a ruler throughout all the land of Egypt. 9 Haste ye, and **go up to my father, and say unto him, Thus saith thy son Joseph, God hath made me lord of all Egypt: come down unto me, tarry not**: 10 And thou shalt dwell in the land of Goshen, and thou shalt be near unto me, thou, and thy children, and thy children's children, and thy flocks, and thy herds, and all that thou hast: 11 And there will I nourish thee; for yet there are five years of famine; lest thou, and thy household, and all that thou hast, come to poverty.
- ⁴⁷ Gen 45:6 For **these two years hath the famine been in the land: and yet there are five years**, in the which there shall neither be earing nor harvest.
- ⁴⁸ Gen 47:9 And **Jacob said unto Pharaoh, The days of the years of my pilgrimage are an hundred and thirty years**: few and evil have the days of the years of my life been, and have not attained unto the days of the years of the life of my fathers in the days of their pilgrimage.
- ⁴⁹ Gen 47:28 And Jacob lived in the land of Egypt seventeen years: so **the whole age of Jacob was an hundred forty and seven years**.
- ⁵⁰ Gen 50:22 And Joseph dwelt in Egypt, he, and his father's house: and **Joseph lived an hundred and ten years**.
- ⁵¹ Exo 6:16 And these are the names of the sons of Levi according to their generations; Gershon, and Kohath, and Merari: and **the years of the life of Levi were an hundred thirty and seven years**.
